1. Introduction

This document, which applies in conjunction with the General Terms & Conditions of Use and the website's personal data protection policy, provides details of the cookies and tracers used on this website, and the means at your disposal to accept or reject their storage on your device.

The definitions included in the General Terms & Conditions of Use of the website also apply to this policy.

2. Cookies policy

a) What is a cookie?

A cookie is a (generally short) string of texts and numbers identified by a name. It may be stored on a user's device when they access a website or application, via a web browser.

Cookies allow their publishers to identify the devices on which they are stored, throughout their validity or storage period. Cookies are used for various purposes: some are indispensable to the functioning of websites, while others are used to optimise and tailor the content displayed to users, or to generate statistics.

In this Policy, the term cookie is used in its broadest definition encompassing all trackers stored and/or read when you consult our website, whatever device you may be using (computer, smartphone, tablet etc.).

b) Cookies used on this website

There are various types of cookies present on this website:

1. Cookies necessary for the smooth running of the website

These cookies allow the website to function correctly.

You can refuse to accept these cookies, and delete them using the relevant settings in your browser. However, without these cookies you will not be able to use the website properly and your user experience is likely to suffer as a result.

We cannot accept any liability for any consequences which might arise if the website and its services do not function correctly because it has not been possible to store or consult the necessary cookies because you declined or deleted them.

2. Cookies requiring your consent

These optional cookies include cookies from third parties, and are used for the purposes described below.

Analytical cookies:
