#### 2.2. Who is able to access your data?

- The organisations and service providers listed in the table below, for the purposes and in the conditions described in this document, strictly within the remit of their professional responsibilities. Our service providers predominantly supply us with IT services.

#### 2.3. Where are your data processed?

- Within the European Union.
- In rare cases, data may be transferred to countries outside the EU.

When transferred, data are protected by a cross-border flow agreement including the standard contractual clauses defined by the European Commission, or by the Binding Corporate Rules (BCR) applicable to service providers.

#### 2.4. How long do we store your data?

The length of time for which we store your data depends on the reason for which they are collected. These reasons are set out in the table below:

# **3** Your rights

#### 3.1. What are your rights?

- Right of access
- Right to delete data which is inaccurate,incomplete, ambiguous, outdated or which it would be illegal to handle.
- Right to modify data
- Right to impose directives on the storage, deletion and sharing of data after your death.
- Right of opposition
- Right to restrict handling.
- Data **portability** right.

#### 3.2. How can you exercise your rights?
